



CatholicCare Educational and Cognitive Assessments for Schools

Educational and Cognitive assessments are available through CatholicCare to assist with planning for educational and behavioural needs and for applications for funding support.

CatholicCare psychologists can administer cognitive assessments, including the most recent Wechsler Intelligence Scales for Children (WISC-V and WPPSI-IV). Adaptive assessment using the Vineland Adaptive Behaviour Scales (Vineland-3) is also available when appropriate. Other investigative tools such as the Child Behaviour Checklist can be offered if required to screen for behavioural concerns.

Assessment cost is dependent on whether schools have a School Counselling contract with CatholicCare.

Service includes:

- an assessment conducted on site at the school
- a comprehensive written report
- verbal feedback session for teachers and parents
